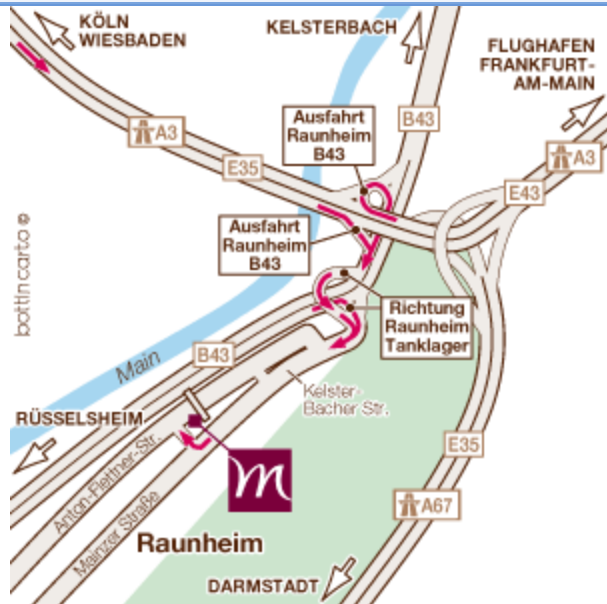


Anfahrt map & directions



Das in Raunheim gelegene Mercure Hotel Wings Frankfurt Airport ist über einen kostenlosen Shuttle (Terminal 1; Ankunft, Ausgang A1) mit dem Flughafen Frankfurt/Main verbunden. Sie erreichen es aber auch über die 500 m entfernte Bushaltestelle Egerländer Straße und die Autobahn A3, Abfahrt Raunheim. Zur S-Bahn-Station und zum Business Area Prime Parc Raunheim sind es je fünf Fahrminuten. Das Messe- und Kongresszentrum in Frankfurt und das Zentrum der Mainmetropole erreichen Sie in 20 Minuten.

Situated in Raunheim, the Mercure Hotel Wings Frankfurt Airport can be reached from Frankfurt/Main Airport via a free shuttle (Terminal 1; Arrivals, Exit 1). The hotel can also be easily accessed via the Egerländer Straße bus stop 550 yards away and via the Raunheim exit from the A3 highway. The S-Bahn station and the Prime Parc Raunheim business area are 5 minutes by car. The exhibition and congress center in Frankfurt and the center of the city on the Main are all 20 mins away.
